



Family = A primary, long-lasting developmental context

Temporal interpersonal emotion systems ² { • Closeness ³ • Conflict



- Mother-Adolescent (MA) vs. Father-Adolescent (FA)
- Parent- vs. Adolescent- perceptions of their relationships

Research Questions:

• What are the daily dynamics between parent-adolescent closeness/conflict and adolescent PA/NA?

2

 Whether and how MA and FA dyad may differentially associate with adolescent PA/NA?

3

 Whether and how parent- and adolescent-perceived relationship dynamics may differentially associate with adolescent PA/NA?

Samples, Measures, & Analysis

P-A Daily Relationships

Mother

<u>Closeness</u>: My child was close and connected with me today. <u>Conflict</u>: There was tension between my child and me today.

Father

<u>Closeness</u>: My child was close and connected with me today. <u>Conflict</u>: There was tension between my child and me today.

Adolescent (repeat for both parents)

<u>Closeness</u>: My [parent] was close and connected with me today. <u>Conflict</u>: There was tension between my [parent] and me today.

Adolescent Daily Emotions

Positive Affect

- (1) I experienced a lot of joy today.
- (2) Today was a fun day.

Negative Affect

- (1) Today was a very frustrating day.
- I experienced a lot of anxiety today.

Analytic model: Vector Autoregressive (VAR) Model

Four VAR models

- PA closeness + PA conflict + adolescent Pos + adolescent Neg
- (1) M-report MA, (2) F-report FA, (3) A-report MA, and (4) A-report FA

Within-family level

- Same-day concurrent associations among all four variables per model
- Next-day lagged associations between each variable pairs + all stability paths

Between-family level

Correlations among all key variables and estimated parameters



Sample info:

- Up to 30 days from M, F, & A in two-caregiver families
- N=107 families, n=3210 days
- Age:

Adolescent: 11-18, M=14.75 (S/F)mother: 31-64, M=42.78 (S/F)father: 30-71, M=43.02


• Gender:

59% males, 38% females, 3.0% non-binary or prefer not to say

- Race/ethnicity:
 59% White, 29% Black,
 3% Hispanic, 4% Asian,
 5% Mixed races
- Household Income:
 Median \$80,000~\$89,999




















Day-level

Family-level

Summary & take home message

FA closeness/conflict (as perceived both by fathers and adolescents) is more reciprocal with adolescent PA/NA

- FA conflict → (+) Adolescent NA
- Adolescent PA \rightarrow (+) FA closeness
- MA ←→ Adolescent PA/NA differ by M- vs. A- perception
 - M-perceived: Adolescent PA→ MA closeness
 - A-perceived: None in lagged-day
- Adolescents with higher closeness with both parents (as perceived both by parents and adolescents) tend to have higher PA
- MA vs. FA nuances:
 - MA conflict (perceived both by M and A) $\leftarrow \rightarrow$ (-) Adolescent PA
 - FA conflict (perceived both by F and A) $\leftarrow \rightarrow$ (+) Adolescent NA

Overall

- Take-home message:
 - More daily reciprocity between FA interactions and adolescent PA/NA
 - Closer relationship with parents ←→ Adolescent higher PA
 - FA conflict as a robust indicator and point of intervention for adolescent NA
